

BLANCA CUESTA: International Exhibition in Qatar

Blanca Cuesta will participate in a new international exhibition, this time in Doha, Qatar. The works of the artist can be visited from January 20, 2020 in Katara Cultural Village, a spectacular space designed to host all the cultural events of the country that has come true thanks to His Highness Sheikh Hamad Bin Khalifa Al-Thani, Father Emir of the State of Qatar.
